ENEE 610 Information for presentations

1. At the beginning of the presentation every Presenter should have a hand-out of one page (26 copies). These will be graded as part of the base paper grade and should include the main circuit under study, key equations, key results obtained or expected, and points of the presentation in bullet form.

Presentations should be in Power Point for which a computer and projector should be arranged as soon as possible by the First Presenter of the period through the ECE Help Desk, room AVW 1449A; students should load their files prior to the class period since the time allocated for the presentation is so small. Other presenters should double check that the computer has been reserved and if not make a reservation.

2. At the end of the presentation the Commentator should hand in one copy of three written questions that are to be orally raised by the Commentator at the end of the Presenter's presentation. These too will be graded primarily as to depth of concept.
