

ENEE 434 Information for presentations

1. At the beginning of the presentation every Presenter should have a hand-out of one page (40 copies). These will be graded and should include the main algorithm or circuit under study, key equations, key results obtained or expected, and points of the presentation in bullet form.

An overhead projector will be available but if computer presentation is desired that should be arranged as soon as possible by the Presenter through Ms. Julie Napp, room AVW 1445.

2. At the end of the presentation the Commentator should hand in (1 copy) three written questions that are to be orally raised by the Commentator at the end of the Presenter's presentation. These too will be graded primarily as to depth of concept.
