

ENEE 434 Information for presentations

1. At the beginning of the presentation every Presenter should have a hand-out of one page (38 copies). These will be graded and should include the main algorithm or important information of the ANN under study, key equations, key results obtained or expected, and points of the presentation in bullet form.

Computer power point presentations are most desired since they are becoming standard for professional society presentations. The equipment should be arranged as soon as possible by the Presenter through Ms. Julie Napp, room AVW 1445.

2. At the end of the presentation the Commentator should hand in (1 copy) three written questions that are to be orally raised by the Commentator at the end of the Presenter's presentation. These too will be graded primarily as to depth of concept.
