

### ENEE 302 Information for presentations

1. At the beginning of the presentation every Presenter should have a hand-out of one page (60 copies). These will be graded and should include the main circuit under study and important information on its operation, key equations, key results obtained or expected with points of the presentation in bullet form.

Computer power point presentations are most desired since they are becoming standard for professional society presentations. The equipment should be arranged (reserved) as soon as possible by the first presenter (and checked by the others) through the ECE help desk, room AVW 1449, and brought to class by the first presenter or arranged to use that from ENEE 434.

2. At the end of the presentation the Commentator should hand in (1 copy) three written questions that are to be orally raised by the Commentator at the end of the Presenter's presentation. These too will be graded primarily as to depth of concept.
