The term paper should have a thorough discussion of your base paper and

1. Be no longer than 10 pages (1.5 space, 12 point)
2. Follow the structure of an IEEE transactions' paper
3. Contain the base circuit and **your** main simulation and results in the body.
4. Give the theory with analytic treatment of operation of the circuit as well as a discussion with open problems.
5. Have full reference data and especially give exact reference data for anything copied from the literature.
6. Appendices to any reasonable length are allowed.
