The term paper should have a thorough discussion of your base paper and

- 1. Be no longer than 10 pages (1.5 space, 12 point)
- 2. Follow the structure of an IEEE transactions' paper (need not be two columns)
- 3. Contain the base circuit, your main simulations, theory, and measurement results in the body along with layout and extraction data.
 - 4. Give the theory with analytic treatment of operation of the circuit as well as a discussion with open problems. Long derivations to go into appendices.
 - 5. Have full reference data (and directly on copied material).
 - 6. Appendices to any reasonable length are allowed.
