Some general comments so you have some feedback when you work on lab reports.

- The easiest way to lose points is to skip a section. Make sure you've attempted all parts of the lab.
- Every plot should be accompanied by a description. There's not much point to doing a lab if you don't know why you're doing the experiments in the procedure, so make sure you explain what and why for every section.
- Please include schematics (copy-paste screenshots of the lab assignment) so that I can easily follow what circuit your data corresponds to, and you can remember what you did when you look over your lab in the future.
- If you're asked to calculate something, show all the steps. Better to get a wrong answer with mostly correct reasoning than just state a number without an explanation.
